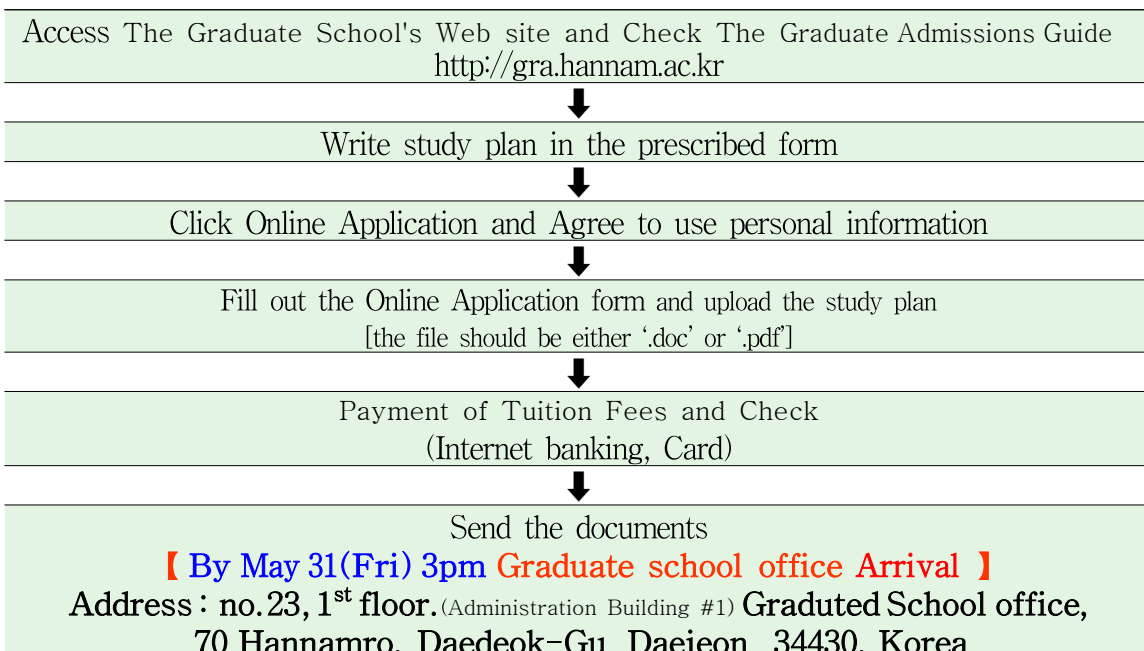

 - (1) Document Screening : 100 points(Study Plan 50 points, Cumulative G.P.A 50 points)
 - (2) Oral Interview : 100 points(Academic Knowledge 60 points, Academic Aptitude 20 points, Academic Sincereness 20 points)

IX. Things You Should Know Before You Apply

- (1) Only online application is available. (Sending by post or visiting in person are not accepted.)
- (2) Submitted documents and application fee will NOT be returned to the applicants.
- (3) If there are any false statements, the admission would be canceled or nullified immediately and automatically
- (4) It is only before your payment that you are allowed to modify your information on the documents.
- (5) Graduate School of HNU give an examinee's number
- (6) Online Application will be printed out by Graduate school, So you don't submit it.
- (7) Your documents must be arrived by **May 31 (Fri) 3pm** in The Graduate School office.
- (8) In case there are missing documents, the applicants must take responsibility and the admission/entrance will be cancelled.
- (9) Non presenter and inadequate applicant's admission would be canceled or nullified immediately and automatically.
- (10) You should have ID card at Oral Interview.
- (11) Further details, if not stated in this guide, it will be processed in accordance with HNU standards.
- (12) Foreign university graduate must submit a notarized/certified translation in Korean.

- (14) A study visa(D2) issuance belongs in the jurisdiction of Korean Embassy or Consulate General, thus an admission offer does not guarantee a visa issuance.
- (15) Successful International applicants would be canceled the admission accordingly in the following cases.
 - If the successful applicants residing out of Korea don't apply for a study visa(D2) until July 31, 2024.
 - If the successful applicants who submitted a certificate of expected graduation don't submit the graduation certificate(actual diploma) until August 23, 2024.
- (16) Successful applicants must thoroughly comply with the Immigration Control Act and the visa application period, and successful applicants are responsible for any disadvantages (no visa issuance, fines, etc.) caused by non-compliance.
